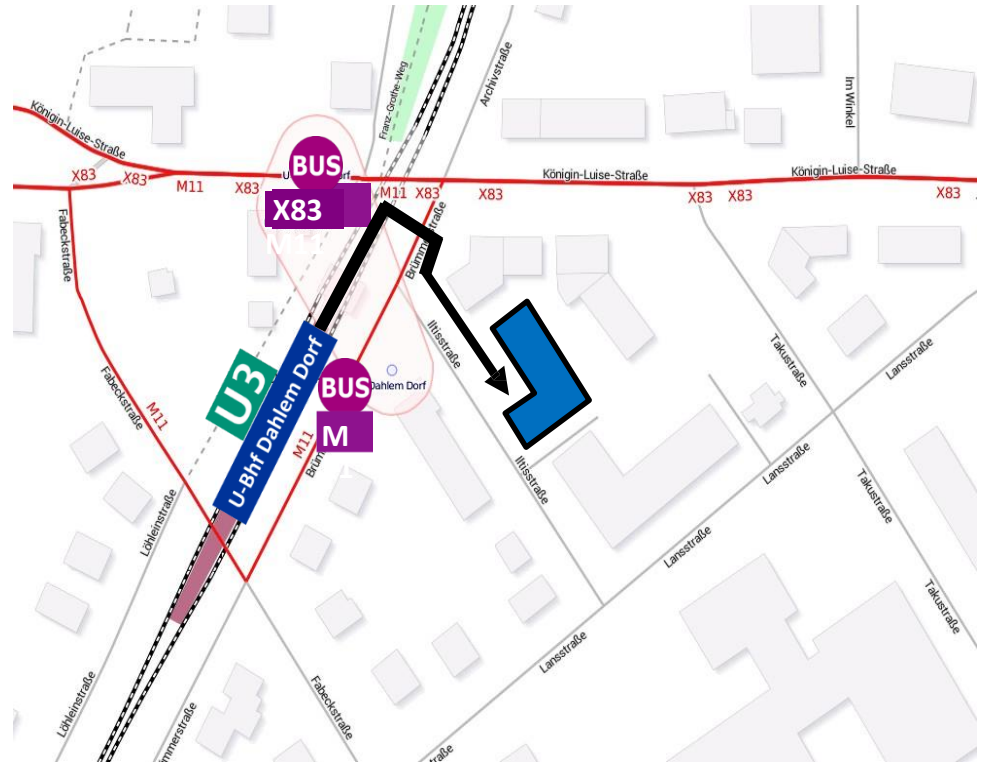

- Very good grades

Application documents:

- Enrollment certificate
- Filled application form
- CV
- *Study Proposal* (about 2 pages)
- List of courses including all grades
- BA/MA Certificate with transcript for MA Students/PhD*
- TOEFL (at least 100 points in the iBT)
- University of California: 90 points in the iBT or 7.0 points IELTS or Cambridge (except for UC Berkeley)
- 2 Letters of Recommendation (Semester programme BA: *one* letter of recommendation)
- For PhD: letter confirming supervision by a faculty member from the U.S. partner university

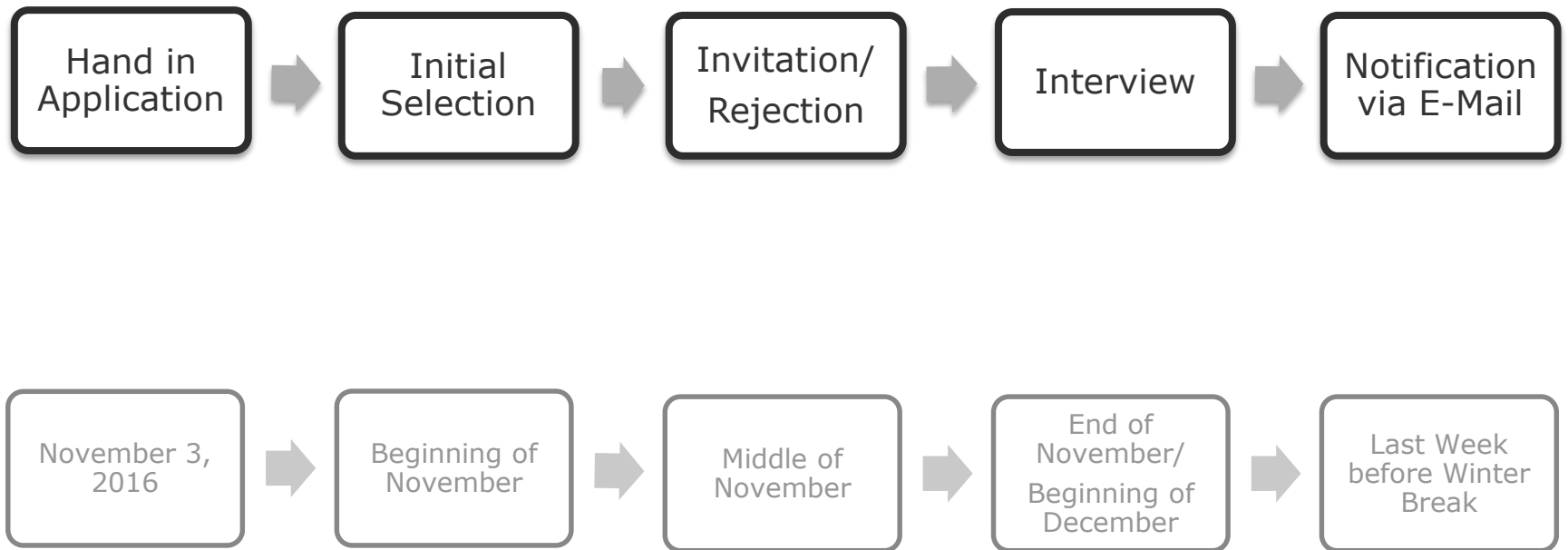

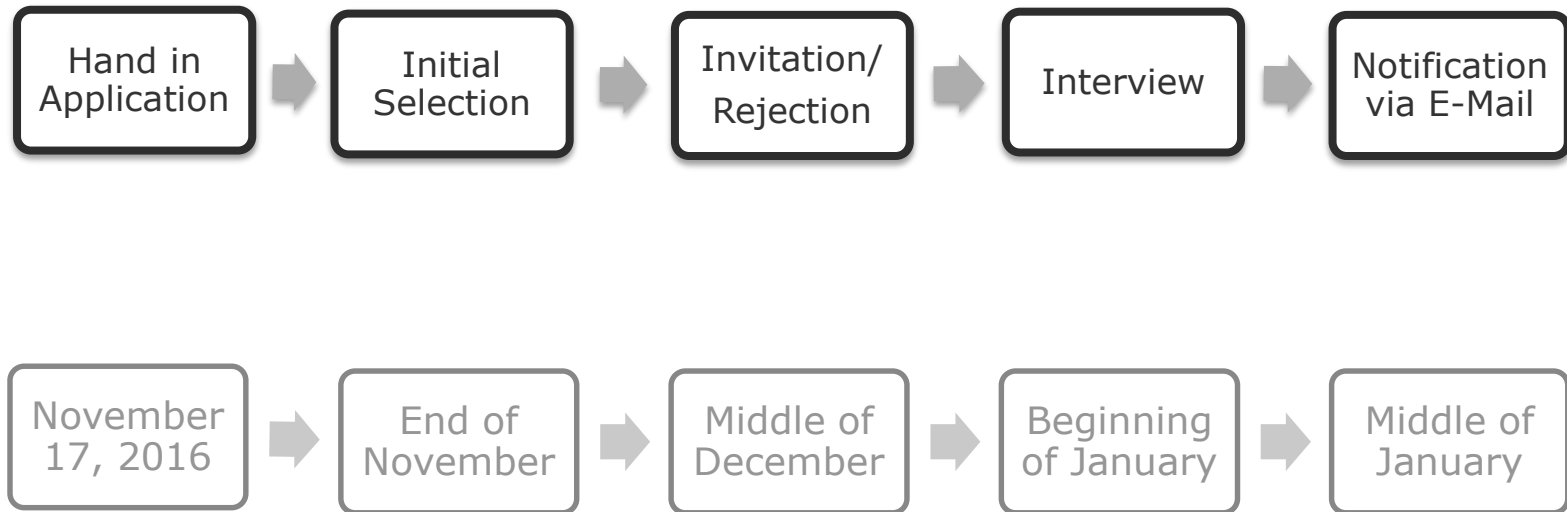
