Annually, short-term Terra Visiting Professorships in American Art are available to senior scholars whose work examines the history of American art. Two five-week visiting professorships are available at the Courtauld Institute of Art with a stipend of \$21,000. Two five-week visiting professorships are available at the consortium formed between the Ecole Normale Supérieure, the Université de Paris Ouest – Nanterre La Défense and the Université François-Rabelais, Tours with a stipend of \$20,000. Four three-month visiting professorships are available at the Freie Universität with a stipend of \$35,000. At each institution, visiting professors will present a seminar and public lecture, work in close collaboration with the academic community, and act as mentors for graduate students. All courses will be taught in English.
