Theme of the Conference:

In the many political, cultural, and academic relationships between the United States and Berlin, the encounter of African American intellectuals and artists with the city provides a fascinating chapter of its own. Leading African American intellectuals like W.E.B. du Bois and Alain Locke studied in Berlin, writers like Langston Hughes and Countee Cullen, or, at a later date, Adrienne Kennedy and Audre Lorde, learned to appreciate the cosmopolitan atmosphere of the city, and artists like Josephine Baker and Paul Robeson enriched the artistic life of the city. The conference will attempt an assessment of the influences that resulted from the encounter between African Americans and Berlin.
