Tomasz Basiuk received his doctoral degree from the University of Warsaw in 1997. His research interests include contemporary American fiction and life writing, critical theory, and queer studies. He published a monograph on William Gaddis (*Wielki Gaddis. Realista postmodernistyczny*, 2003), co-edited three volumes of papers on queer studies: *Odmiany odmieñca / A queer mixture* (2002), *Paramety pożądania* (2006) and *Out There* (2006), and a volume of papers in American Studies titled *American Uses of History* (2011). He is on the editorial board of *InterAlia*, a queer studies e-journal (www.interalia.org.pl). In 2004-2005, he was Fulbright Senior Visiting Scholar at The CUNY Graduate Center. He has been director of the University of Warsaw American Studies Center since 2005.
