## RnR as a phenomenon of "re-colonization", a musical genre shaping across the Atlantic, ca. 1954-1964

## **Selected timeline**

- 1931 Electric guitar invented
- 1951 March, Jackie Brenston and His Delta Cats record 'Rocket 88'
- 1954 April 12<sup>th</sup>, Bill Haley and His Comets record 'Rock Around the Clock'
  - July 5<sup>th</sup>, Elvis Presley records 'That's All Right (Mama)'
- 1955 January 14<sup>th</sup>, Alan Freed organises the first 'rock and roll' concert
  - March 19<sup>th</sup>, film 'Blackboard Jungle' premiers in New York
  - May 21st, Chuck Berry records 'Maybelline'
  - September 3<sup>rd</sup>, Little Richard records 'Tutti Frutti'
  - December 19<sup>th</sup>, Carl Perkins records 'Blue Suede Shoes'
- **1956** March 24<sup>th</sup>, *Rock n' Roll Dance Party* premiers with Alan Freed on CBS radio
  - June 5<sup>th</sup>, Elvis performs 'Hound Dog' on *The Milton Berle Show*
- 1957 February 8<sup>th</sup>, Bo Diddley records 'Bo Diddley'
  - February 25<sup>th</sup>, Buddy Holly records 'That'll Be The Day'
  - July 6<sup>th</sup>, John Lennon and Paul McCartney
  - August 5<sup>th</sup>, American Bandstand begins its 30 year syndicated run
  - October 8<sup>th</sup>, Jerry Lee Lewis records 'Great Balls of Fire'
  - Little Richard ceases recording to become a minister
- **1958** January 8<sup>th</sup>, Chuck Berry records 'Johnny B. Goode'
  - March 24<sup>th</sup>, Elvis joins the army
  - Jerry Lee Lewis' career is scandalised after he marries his cousin

- **1959** February 3<sup>rd</sup>, Buddy Holly, Ritchie Valens and The Big Bopper die in a plane crash
  - Chuck Berry arrested; legal issues remain until 1963
  - Payola hearings begin
- 1960 April 14<sup>th</sup>, Motown and Tamla merge to form Motown Record Corporation.
  - April 17<sup>th</sup>, Eddie Cochran killed in a car crash
  - August 1<sup>st</sup>, The Beatles make their debut in Hamburg
  - Payola made illegal
- **1961** January 15<sup>th</sup>, Motown records sign The Supremes
  - October 3<sup>rd</sup>, The Beach Boys release 'Surfin', their debut single
- 1962 April 7<sup>th</sup>, Mick Jagger and Keith Richards meet Brian Jones
- 1963 February 22nd, 'Please Please Me' by The Beatles reaches #1 in the U.K.
  - March 17<sup>th</sup>, The Kinks form
  - November 22<sup>nd</sup>, With The Beatles is released in the U.K.
- **1964** February 9<sup>th</sup>, The Beatles perform on *The Ed Sullivan Show* 
  - April 4<sup>th</sup>, The Beatles occupy all top 5 spots on the Billboard Chart
  - August 26<sup>th</sup>, The Kinks release 'You Really Got Me'
  - September 5<sup>th</sup>, 'The House of the Rising Sun' becomes #1 in the U.S.
  - October 25<sup>th</sup>, The Rolling Stones perform on The Ed Sullivan Show
